

Introduction

This year has been a challenging year across the globe. The COVID-19 pandemic has transformed life in its normality. As an organisation we have had to pivot and adjust swiftly to the new way of life without changing our core focus. Waumbe's vision is to instil purpose and hope into the lives of the youth, to provide meaningful opportunities for youth in under-resourced communities (Fisantekraal in particular).

For our first time readers, here is a quick history of Waumbe's journey. In 2015 Waumbe conducted a community study in collaboration with Won Life. The goal of the study was to have a clear understanding of community challenges and identify the causes of poor academic performance and the high numbers of high school learner drop-outs. From this study the results indicated the following factors:

- Lack of Career Guidance
- Poor Academic Performance
- Lack of Role Models from the Community
- Social Decay

Based on the study, Waumbe's current goal is to implement programmes that progressively address the above factors by addressing the root causes of the identified challenges. These programmes have been packed to provide holistic development for the youth.

Programme Delivery

In 2021 we managed to implement our programmes with good success. The programmes that we offered are as follows:

- Academic Support: tutoring for high school learners.
- Career Guidance Programmes: for all youth in the community
- Post-matric Application drives: university, colleges, and learnerships.
- Job placements and job readiness workshops: aimed at unemployed youth in the community.
- Accredited IT and Business Administration training courses: open to the communities surrounding Fisantekraal.
- Societal Reformation Curriculum: for all youths in the community.

These accreditations assist Waumbe to offer Accredited IT training short courses and facilitate learnerships.

Waumbe is constantly looking for companies to partner with in facilitating learnerships that aim at improving the skills and employability of the youth resultantly, leading to employment creation.

2021 SUCCESS STORIES

1. Achieved Technical Support NQF Level 4 (IT) South African Qualification Authority (SAQA) MICTSETA Accreditation 2021.
2. Waumbe nominated as a YearBeyond Implementing Partner in 2021 by the Youth and After School Programme under the Western Cape Government Department of Cultural Affairs and Sport in partnership with Community Chest. Through this initiative we work with five schools during and after school to assist learners to improve their academic performance. ***This program has facilitated employment of 28 young people between the ages of 18 and 25***, which is a huge boast in addressing youth unemployment.
3. ***Youth employment facilitation to 15 young people***, with the following companies Intambiso Projects and Leadership Services and Youth@Work in partnership with Nedbank.
4. ***Learnership program currently has an enrollment of 10 young people, 7 of them youth living with disabilities on Technical Support NQF Level 4 in partnership with Invigor8 Innovative Social Transformation (Pty) Ltd, Energy Partners Holdings (Pty) Ltd and Dax Data (Pty) Ltd.***

Life Skills Programs (SOCIAL REFORM 2021)

The life skills sessions held were aimed at addressing issues of personal development and create self-awareness. To help young people understand the greatness in them, and how to fulfill their potential. The sessions covered topics directed at young men that are struggling with issues of absent fathers, integrity, managing romantic relationships, and taking responsibilities. For the ladies sessions we covered topics such as, “**How to love yourself as a woman**”, “**Being proud of your body**” and “**Why women were created**”.

WAUMBE UPCOMING PROJECTS JULY 2021 TO DECEMBER 2021

1. **Training of 100 unemployed youth** This project requires Waumbe to set up a new lab in the hall, as the current lab will not suffice under COVID19 protocols, the new lab set up will cost Waumbe R25000. The IT network infrastructure has been set up sponsored by Rubics IT Services.

Waumbe requires 25 computers to rollout this project; we are grateful to Shoprite SA who have donated 10 computers, now we need 15 more. This project will be targeted at school dropouts and unemployed youth. The cost for purchase 15 computers with software is ZAR149 255.28 quotation available on request.

2. **Job Readiness training for 60 unemployed graduates** in partnership with FCD (Fisantekraal Centre for Development) The cost for the training is **ZAR65000**. Proposals for these programs available on request.
3. Waumbe's growth has exceeded our expectations the current facility is no longer sufficient to cater for our operations and programme delivery. That has forced Waumbe to embark on Centre Expansion and Renovations. The plans for this project is currently with the Municipality for approval, the cost to realize this dream is **ZAR 2 025 638** quotation available on request.
