Target group	Children from Khayelitsha: reception year and primary school (Grades R/0-7)
Activities	<p>Holistic creative education in order to develop responsible citizens of society, able to live fulfilling lives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use of rhythmic verse, songs and movement at the start of each day and during lessons • Three week learning-block cycles • Learners create their textbooks from scratch, first crafting the alphabet letter-by-letter, then sentences, then more and more complex descriptions of the world as each year unfolds <p>Artistic work in addition to music – painting, drawing, ring games, drama and crafts.</p>
